

## 7

Fit the left bracket plate with the long spacers and original bolts and tighten.

## 8

Fit the Öhlin shock absorber with the long bolt and spacers supplied to the upper bracket and with the supplied to the lower bracket on the swing. The fluid reservoir is to be faced the left side of the motorcycle. The Öhlins shock absorber will replace both the original spring and the rotation shock absorber.

## 9

Reassemble the pedal support, the foot rest plate and the rear tank bracket. Finally fit the seat with the two bolts.

### NOTE!

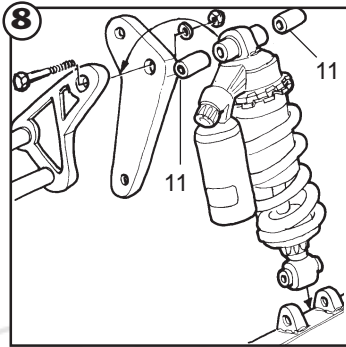
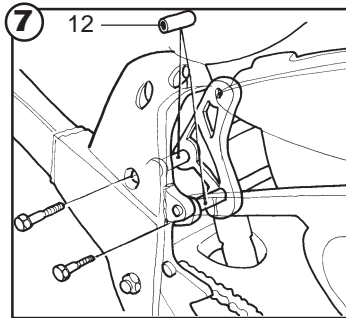
Make sure that all bolts are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls the shock absorber when the suspension is being compressed. See: Motorcycle workshop manual.

### WARNING

Certain modifications are necessary to install the Öhlins shock absorber. It is vital that the mounting instructions are carefully followed.

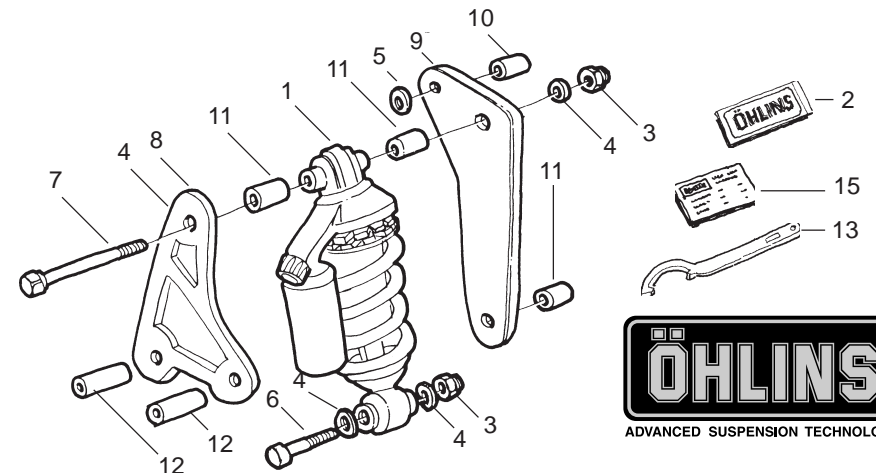

## Kit contents

Before installing the shock absorber kit, please check the contents, listed on the front page of this instruction. If anything is missing, contact your Öhlins dealer.

### NOTE!

During storage and transportation, especially at high ambient temperature, the oil and grease used for assembling may run out inside the packing and damage the expanded polystyrene packing material. This is not unusual and is in no way detrimental to the shock absorber.

Installing a shock absorber, that is not approved by the motorcycle manufacturer, may affect the stability of your motorcycle. Öhlins Racing AB can't be held responsible for any personal injury or damage whatsoever which may occur after fitting the shock absorber.

## Mounting instructions

### 1

Put the motorcycle on a stand so that the rear wheel is clear of the ground. Make sure it is fixed so it will not fall over.

### ⚠ WARNING!

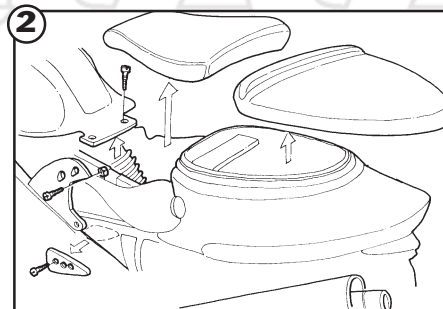
1. It's advisable to have an Öhlins dealer or other qualified person to fit your shock absorber.

2. Instructions in the motorcycle workshop manual are to be followed when changing the shock absorber.

3. When working on the motorcycle it must be securely supported to prevent it from falling over.

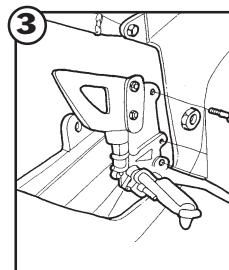
### 2

Remove the two bolts holding the front seat and lift it off. Loosen the rear tank bracket, so the rear end of the tank can be raised. Remove the plate at the left foot rest.



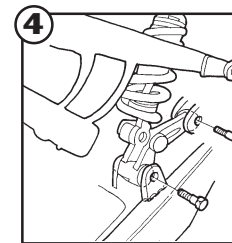
### 3

Remove the foot rest support on the right side by loosening the three bolts.



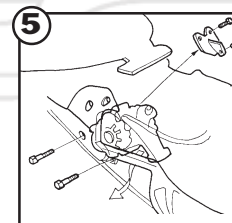
### 4

Loosen the linkage from the frame and from the swinging arm rear fork. Loosen the upper mount of the original spring unit.



### 5

Loosen the three bolts of the original shock absorber and the bracket on the inside and take the whole unit, including linkage, out by turning it carefully and pulling. Then pull out the original spring unit together with the triangle link the same way.

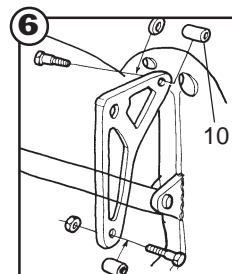


### 6

Fit the right bracket plate with the spacer (10, 11) and original bolts and tighten.

### NOTE!

The spacing washer is to be positioned between the plate and the inside of the left upper.
