How to install

▲ Warning!

It is advisable to have an Öhlins dealer install the shock absorber.

When installing, consult your Vehicle Service Manual.

1

Put the motorcycle on a workstand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground.

▲ Warning!

Make sure the vehicle is securely supported so that it will not tip.

2

Remove the seat and the plastic panel on the right side of the bike.

3

Remove the original shock absorber. Raise the wheel slightly so that the rear bolt can be removed.

Note!

Before installing the Öhlins shock absorber clean the vehicle thoroughly.

4

Install the Öhlins shock absorber

- rebound adjuster and length adjuster at the upper bracket in the frame
- reservoir pointing to the left at the lower swing arm bracket

Raise the rear wheel slightly so that the rear bolt can be installed.

• Note!

If you want to access the rebound adjuster without removing the right side cover, it is possible to drill a small hole in the side panel for a small screwdriver.

Note!


Lower the motorcycle so that the shock absorber is sligthly compressed, before tightening the screws.

Caution!

Make sure that all screws are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.
